

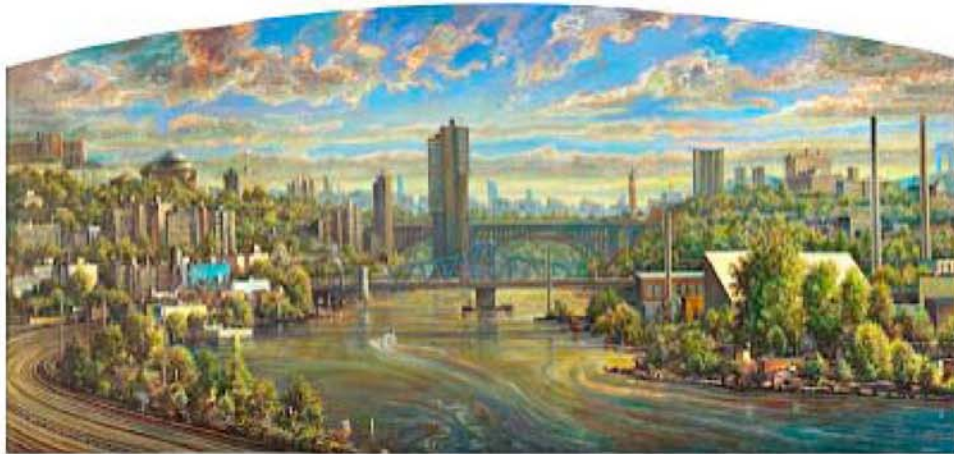

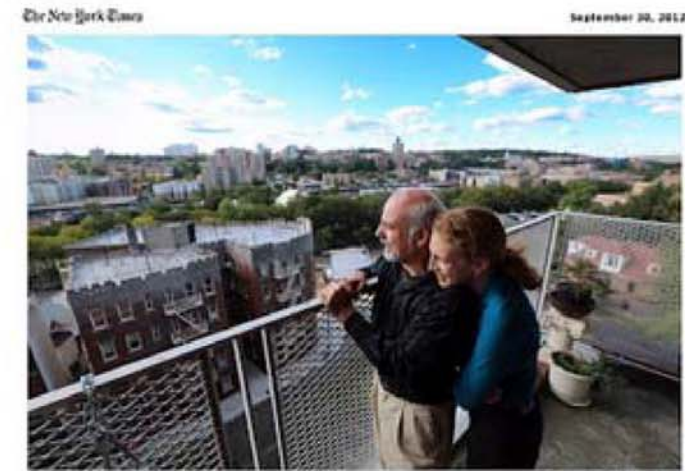


"View of the Harlem River" by Daniel Hauben

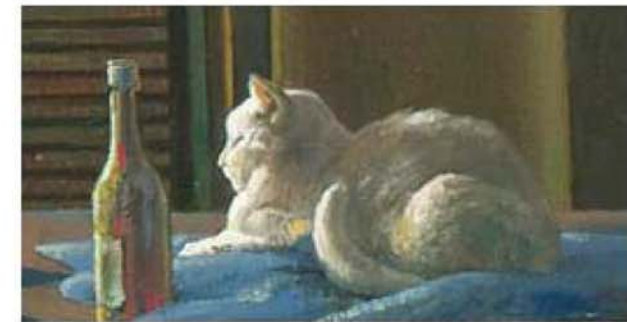
